The Computerized Assessment and Referral System (CARS) has been adapted as a mental health screening instrument.

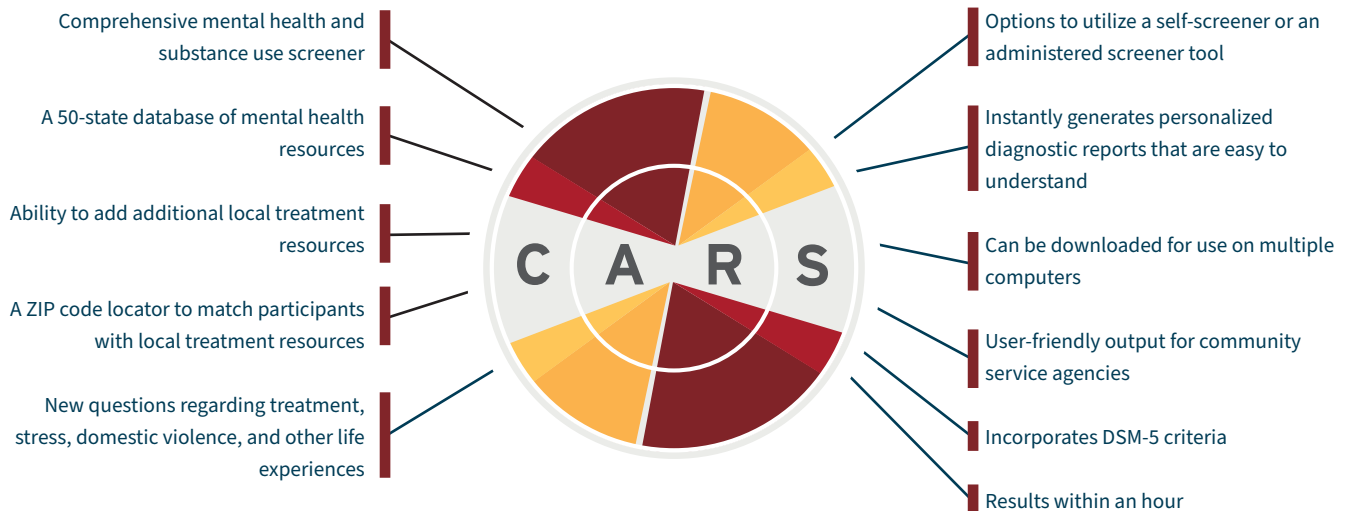
CARS IS A FREE SCREENING AND ASSESSMENT TOOL

created by the Cambridge Health Alliance at Harvard Medical School to identify substance use and mental health disorders and connect people to treatment resources. Originally created for criminal justice practitioners to help identify individuals with psychiatric co-morbidity, it has now been adapted for a broader audience to help all people in crisis. The new screener is available on open-source software.
